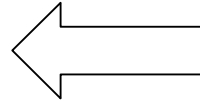


Getting out and about

What you have told us.....



There is a desire to extend the Walks about Wootton programme.

There is a need to protect access to sensitive areas of the countryside but at the same time opening it up to walkers.

Access to the beach is seen as vital and the pathway leading down to Woodside needs to be maintained to encourage a wide range of users.

More access to the Creek is seen as desirable, where possible.

The open views from both sides of the bridge are very important and must be maintained.

Footways and footpaths should be maintained and improved to cater for the elderly and disabled.

A safe pedestrian crossing is needed at the bottom end of the High Street near the Sloop.

The provision of a footbridge and cycleway on the north side of the Bridge would be welcomed.

The relationship with the village and the Steam Railway should be maintained to help promote matters of mutual interest.

Getting out and about

Responses from the Youth Club:

Extension of the Walks about Wootton programme was deemed to be boring.

It is felt that the beach area is unsafe.

The open views on both sides of the bridge should be kept.

The Kings Quay area should be left alone and not opened up for public access.

The provision of a cycleway on the north side of the bridge is supported.

The Steam Railway is seen as being for older people and babies.
