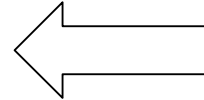


Highways and Traffic

What you have told us.....



There is a need for safe pedestrian crossings in the High Street, especially at the Brannon Way/ High Street junction and by The Sloop.

The new crossing by Hardwoods should be better lit.

Rectory Drive and Mary Rose Avenue are rat runs and safety measures need to be taken to control traffic speed.

Double yellow lines should only be installed where there is a safety issue.

Traffic speed is of concern and measures are needed to reduce speed and enforce the limits.

Residential roads should have a 20mph speed limit.

There is strong support for continued cycling provision.

Highways and Traffic

Responses from the Youth Club:

- **There should be less double yellow lines as there is nowhere to park**
- **There should be 20mph speed limits of our side roads.**
- **Cycle tracks should be provided on our roads.**
- **The effects of traffic movement through the village should be minimised to protect the well being of our residents.**
- **The crossing at Tesco is of particular concern in terms of safety.**
