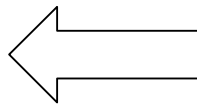


# **Our countryside and coastline**

**What you have told us.....**



**Residents are very aware of their surroundings and express a fine balance between opening up access to the countryside and leaving it as it is.**

**Opening up of the coastline for walking where possible is desirable but there is also a desire to leave it as a nature reserve.**

**Private land should not be requisitioned to provide public access.**

**The coastline should be allowed to change by natural processes with sparing use of hard defences for the protection of property.**

**The Creek should be protected for the future by developing an Estuary Management Plan.**

**There should be a harbour authority to regulate the Fishbourne ferry port.**

**Residents wish to see better protection of our coastline and creek.**

**Opening up of the countryside for public access should be done with care as there are concerns over damage to habitats. Private property should be respected.**

**Areas of our countryside should be reserved up for wildlife.**

**More tree and hedge planting is seen as desirable.**

**There is a desire for the Tree Warden to compile informative walks around the village.**

**The remains of the Old Tidal Mill in Mill Square should be interpreted and developed as an historical project.**
