3. THESE FACILITIES HAVE ALREADY BEEN GIVEN PLANNING PERMISSION ON THE MAIN SITE THEREFORE NO NEED HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED
4. NOISE POLLUTION
5. LIGHT POLLUTION
6. TRAFFIC CONCERNS
7. THAT 1-15 YEARS DOES NOT SEEM TO CONSTITUTE A TEMPORARY BASIS
8. LACK OF EVIDENCE FOR THE PROTECTION OF HIGH AMMENITY TREES
9. THE AREA IS CLASSED AS A GREEN BELT AREA.
