16/078. Recreation Ground

Lee Matthews sent an email explaining that the Isle of Wight Council would stop work at the recreation ground on the 6th May 2016 as the local authority did not have sufficient funds to undertake the full works. The clerk had asked several questions and had obtained the answers (see appendix A). A lively discussion took place regarding whether pruning was required this year.

RESOLVED – THAT THE PARISH COUNCIL WOULD PAY THE AGREED AMOUNT OF £5000 WITH A PROVISIO THAT IF PRUNING IS NOT REQUIRED THIS YEAR THE MONIES WOULD BE REBATED AND CARRIED FORWARD TO THE FOLLOWING YEAR AND A REDUCE CONTRIBUTION WOULD BE REQUIRED IN 2017/18. THIS IS DUE TO THE SEVERE PRUNING THAT WAS DONE IN 2015/16.
